Devil's Maggot

Category: 'Playford' (*modern**)
(NB: a 'classic 3 part' Playford dance, with a Duple Minor progression <u>in each part</u>.)
Formation: Duple Proper
Music: AABB (3x 32b) **NB this is a 32b adaption of the original 24b dance.

Part I

- A1 'Up a Double' and back, & repeat; (*ie twice !*)
- A2 'Down a Double' and back, & repeat;
- B1First Corners Change places, Second Corners Change places, (pass Rt sh.)Partners 2 Hand Turn once and a half,(completes the first progression)
- **B2** Circle (*of 4*) Left, once around, (*with the 2's above*) Partners Set and Turn Single;

Part II

- A1 Partners Side Right, Side Left; (*ie short siding*)
- A2 Neighbours Side Right, Side Left; (*ie with NEW neighbours below*)

B1&2 as in Part I. (but with 'new' 2's below, ie second progression)

Part III

A1 Partners Arm Right, Arm Left;

A2 Neighbours Arm Right, Arm Left; (*ie with NEW neighbours below*)

B1&2 as in Part I. (but with 'new' 2's below, ie third progression)

Repeat. (repeat the whole, *as many times as desired*)

NB: The dance term 'Maggot' in this context means a 'Favourite'.

* Note: Devil's Maggot by Diane Schmit, tune by Jonathan Jensen. The tune and dance were both composed, and first danced, in 1985. However, neither were written down until 1990.

**This arrangement is adapted to suit the selected music '*Up Jumped the Devil*', - a standard 32b traditional American tune. (There is now a 2nd 'A' part in the dance.)
