Music: 4 x 32 bar Reels, Scottish or Australian,

Introduction: Bow to Partner,		(chord or 4b)
<b>A1</b>	Taking partner's right hand, 1st & 2nd couples <b>Cross Over</b> to partner's pla	ace, (2b)
	Retaining right hands, 1st & 2nd couples <b>Star halfway round</b> , (1st & 2nd couples have now changed positions)	(2b)
	<b>1st &amp; 3rd</b> couples repeat, (1st & 3rd couples have now changed positions)	(4b)
A2	<b>1st &amp; 4th</b> couples repeat, (1st & 4th couples have now changed positions) (ie 1st couple is now in 4th position, all other couples have moved up one place)	(4b)
	All couples <b>Turn Partner</b> by the right hand once around,	(4b)
В1	The 2nd with the 3rd couple, and the 4th with the 1st couple, dancing toge <b>Right Hand Star</b> once around, but finish by retaining the right hand of the other person of the same sex, for	ether, (4b)

Repeat the dance for each new top couple in turn.

## **Short Calls:**

1s & 2s : Cross & Half Star, 1s & 3s : Cross & Half Star;

1s & 4s : Cross & Half Star, All Turn Partner;

In 4s: Right Hand Star, same sex: Turn by the Right;

Reels of 4 on the Line.

Note: This is an exclusively "Right Handed" dance – ie all 'Turns' & 'Stars' use the right hand, and the 'Reel of 4' is a "Right Shoulder" reel.

When active, the right hand hold is retained throughout the dance, until the final reel of 4.
